

## The Missing Link: An Investigation into JAK 2 Phosphorylation

**Abstract:** This project is an investigation in which the goal is to determine if JAK2

phosphorylation is an upstream signaling pathway responsible for oxLDL-mediated macrophage survival. The experiment employed a JAK2 inhibitor: AG490. The combination of individual analyses of each set of data indicated that AG490 has a negative, time-dependent, dose-dependent,

specific effect on oxLDL-mediated macrophage survival.
