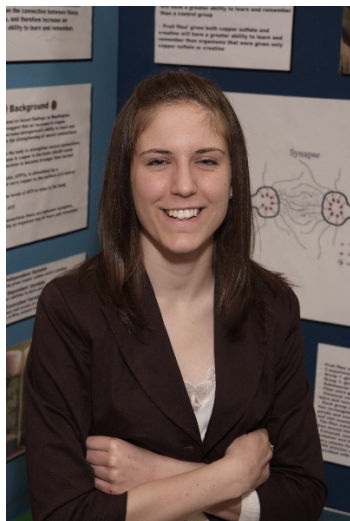

Copper or Coincidence?

Abstract: This project studied whether an increase in copper in the brain could improve an organism's ability to learn and remember.
