## **Onion Power**

Abstract: In attempt to find a more efficient method of producing ethanol from organic

matter, Allium cepa (onions) were fermented by Saccharomyces cerevisiae (yeast). This method produced up to 0.22 grams of ethanol per kilogram of onions in a high school laboratory setting. Using a combination of results and statistical analysis, onions may be the favourable crop for ethanol.
