Abstract: The purpose of the project was to test if artificial neural networks can be used to do reliable image recognition in a computer system. A program was designed to test neural networks in this application, and improved upon using scale invariant feature transforms to increase the accuracy of the system. The current implementation of the neural network is found to be 80 percent accurate.
