Abstract:	Study has two parts. Part one of the study tested effects of three different concentrations of common sugars (table sugar, honey, and sweetener) on oral pH. The results indicated that table sugar had greatest impact on oral pH. Part two of the study tested the effects of sugar-free gum on oral pH. Data collected suggests the sugar substitutes in gum did not significantly alter pH.
