Abstract: Using five North American honeys, the purpose is to determine their

phenolic content and the phenolics' specific contribution to honey's

antimicrobial properties. The best solvent for the phenolics is determined to be ethanol. Phenolics are quantitatively proven not to be the main

antimicrobial agent in three honeys, and to possibly be the main agent in the other two honeys. Overall phenolics have significant antimicrobial

properties.
