Abstract: Does age and gender have an affect on auditory and visual memory? Students aged 6-11 were tested using an increasingly larger series of characters to determine retention. Visual and auditory scores were compared to determine trends, also two schools were tested to validate results. School location did make a difference, but not significantly. Younger students had better auditory memory, but visual memory increased with age.
