Abstract: The present study was designed to evaluate antifungal and antibacterial effects of cinnamon leaf extract, allicin and raw garlic against *Penicillium notatum*, *Pseudomonas fluorescens*, and *Staphylococcus saprophyticus*. The antimicrobial activity was examined by the presence of a zone of inhibition on agar plates. Cinnamon showed excellent inhibitory activity against all microorganisms, allicin exhibited slight inhibitory activity and garlic showed strong inhibition against *Staphylococcus saprophyticus*.
