Abstract: A Java program was created to simulate commuters using a region's

transportation networks to travel to destinations according to the

A*pathfinding algorithm. Then, an experiment was run to test the program, comparing a proposed transit system with an existing one in Sherwood Park. The program predicted that the proposal would increase midday ridership from 5.9% to 8.0%, but also revealed some flaws in the proposal.

Biography

I am 16 years old and currently am in Grade 12 at Old Scona Academic High School. At school, I serve as the Vice President of the Students' Union and am an active member of: the Speech and Debate team, the Football and Frisbee Club, and a tutoring service named Change for Change.
