Abstract: "Hands on the Wheel" compares a driver's ability to concentrate on the road with and without distractions. "Gran Turismo 5" for Playstation was used with a steering wheel, accelerator and brake. Distractions included speaking or text messaging on a cell phone, eating and drinking. Test subjects were categorized by license status and gaming ability. The highest number of crashes occurred while drivers were text messaging.
