Abstract: Part A: Various store bought disinfectants were tested to see which would best inhibit the growth of bacteria *Bacillus Subtilis*. Part B: Homemade disinfectants were tested on the bacteria. *Bacillus Subtilis* was cultured in Petri dishes containing Nutrient Agar. Coloured discs, each treated with a disinfectant were placed on the Nutrient Agar and incubated for 72 hours then observed. Procedure was repeated with part B.
