Evaluation of Mangosteen Fruits and Extracts by HPLC and in Prostate Cancer Cell

Abstract: To determine if the tropical fruit mangosteen has anti-cancer properties on

prostate cancer cells, serial dilutions were made from various sources of mangosteen. These dilutions were then used to challenge two cell lines, LNCaP and PC-3. An assay was performed after 24 and 48 hours of treatment to determine cell viability. Our final results showed a decrease in

cell survival with increasing concentrations of treatment.
