#### Juniper Tree: Breast Cancer Free?

**Abstract:** This project studied the effect of juniper berry extract on breast cancer cell lines (estrogen receptor positive and estrogen receptor negative). The cells were cultured in various concentrations of the extract and the results were studied using cell counts and a spectrophotometer. Results showed that the extract caused significant cell death in both types of breast cancer cell lines.
