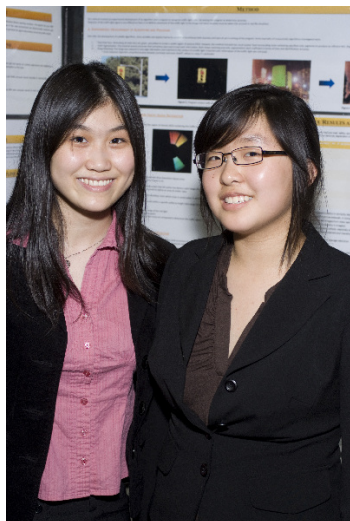

Digital Traffic Signal Recognition System: Saving Lives

Abstract: A digital traffic recognition system is designed to aid color vision deficient or inattentive drivers averting accidents. The system has over 95% accuracy up to a 150m distance. Color and edge information from digital images of the road environment are electronically matched with embedded data. After defining regions of interest, color pixel comparison is used to perceive the signal and produce visual and audio output.
