Abstract: This project attempts to make information on our ecological footprint readily

available to the public by proposing a "footprint meter", a "footprint accounting system" and by providing example calculations for our footprint for items such as a cheeseburger. A simulated model of the footprint meter showing the effect of household energy use is developed. Footprints were

estimated for 12 households through a survey.
