Watching Evolution

Abstract: An original computer program was used to simulate the process of evolution by natural selection, and determine how environmental parameters affect the evolution of populations. The organisms chosen for the populations were mechanical pendulum-clocks, modeled as matrices of heritable data. The results supported the model of punctuated equilibrium, and also determined how changes in various environmental factors affected the evolution of populations.
