Abstract: ABSTRACT; This project tested the effectiveness of seven bow string

silencers (man made and natural). Each silencer was tested fifteen times. The decibel levels were measured, outdoors, from a distance of 30 yards using a low level decibel metre. Of the seven silencers tested - felt silencers

were found to have the lowest readings.
