Is there an alternative to oil-based plastics?

Abstract: This project introduced a biodegradable plastic container to replace the

oil-based container, in purpose to reduce pollution. This was done by combining different concentrations of common household materials to create a durable plastic, then testing the plastic for qualitative and

quantitative results. Results showed that the plastic made with potato starch and 2.5mL of glycerin would be most efficient in replacing the common

oil-based plastic.
