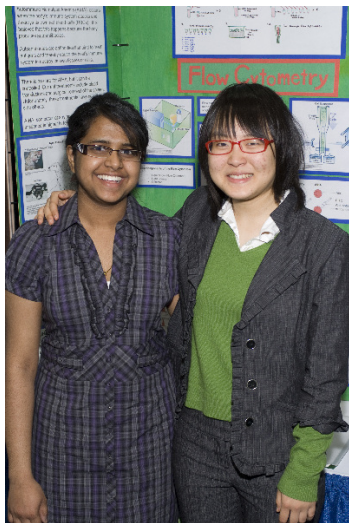

Characterization of Immunoglobulins in Canine Autoimmune Hemolytic Anemia(AIHA)

Abstract: Canine Autoimmune Hemolytic Anemia is mediated by the production of autoantibodies that bind to red blood cells, destroying them. Flow cytometry was used to determine which autoantibodies were responsible for mediating AIHA. It is hypothesized that autoantibody subtypes IgG and IgM bind to the surface of red blood cells. Results showed that IgG, IgG2 and IgM autoantibodies do play a role in mediating Canine AIHA.
