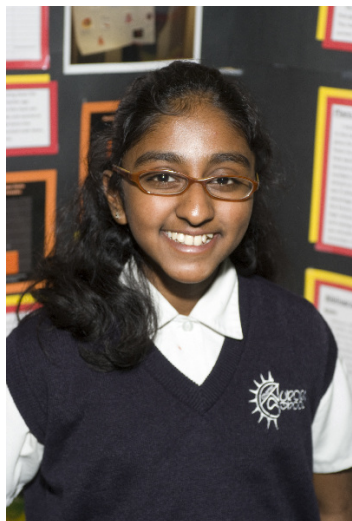

Abstract: My project is based on the effects of gender identity on short-term memory.
