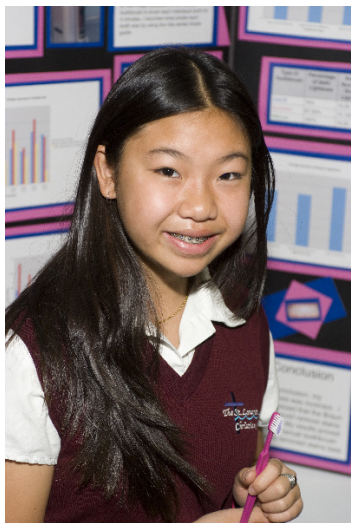

Abstract: This project studied the effectiveness of three different types of toothbrushes, the Phillips Sonicare, the Braun Oral B, and the manual toothbrush, in removing diet coke and coffee stains from extracted human teeth. The changes in shades of the stains were measured using a dental shade guide. The manual toothbrush was found to be the best in removing stains from teeth.
