Game On! How Do You React?

Abstract: This study aimed to determine whether playing video games improved reaction time of participants and whether it could be maintained over time. Reaction time significantly improved for all participants immediately after playing a video game for 15 minutes but was not maintained over time. There were no significant differences in the findings by gender, age or hours of video game playing per week.
