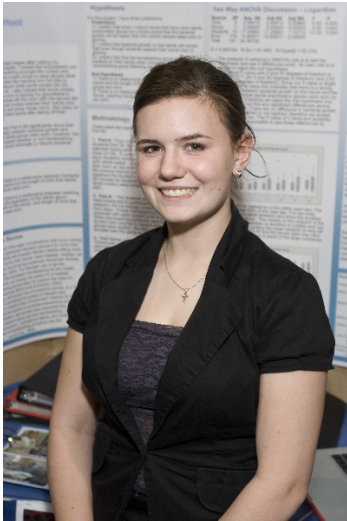

Abstract: The purpose of this research project was to determine if there was a relationship between washing hands prior to the application of the sterile glove, bacterial growth on the hands, and length of time that sterile gloves were worn.
