Out, damn'd Spot! A Randomized Controlled Study of Handwashing.

Abstract: This is a report of a randomized control study which compared the efficacy of soap versus hand sanitizer in Grade 7 students. Blood agar plates were used to culture bacterial colonies left on students' hands after washing. Results demonstrated a statistically significant reduction in number of colonies formed after washing with hand sanitizer compared to soap and water.
