Abstract: This project analyzed whether a person's pessimistic or optimistic outlook

on life can influence their ability to differentiate between authentic and non-authentic smiles. Through an online investigation, subjects chose their outlook on life on a sliding scale, with 1 being optimistic and 7 being pessimistic. Results showed that a subject's outlook on life does not influence their ability to differentiate between authentic and non-authentic

smiles.
