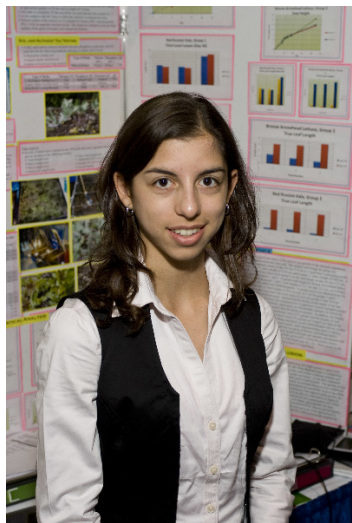

**Abstract:** In response to urban food security, environmental sustainability, and overburdened waste disposal programs, ultra-light extensive green roof panels were utilized with a comprehensive compost tea system to grow locally selected edible plants, resulting in a yield with greater quality and size in comparison to plants produced with fertilizers, while maintaining the benefits of a conventional green roof system.
