Abstract: Chlorine is added to water to protect humans from bacteria. The purpose of this experiment was to see if chlorine has a positive effect on plant growth. Six solutions (different amounts of water and chlorine) and three different types of plants were used. Solution 4 made the plants sprout faster but then stopped their growth. Only the plants hydrated with distilled water survived.
