Abstract: The purpose of this project was to determine if ectoparasite loads had an effect on the number of hatchlings that survived to fledge. My hypothesis was that the greater the ectoparasite loads the fewer hatchlings that would survive to fledge. My results did not support my hypothesis. There is evidence that survival to fledge may have more to do with the adaptability of Tree Swallows.
