## **Bacterial Presence and Contamination of Washed Hands**

Abstract: The purpose of this project was to find an effective way to reduce the risk of

contaminating washed hands when Air Hand Dryers are used in public washrooms, while gaining the economical and environmental benefits. Statistically significant data obtained from testing air quality samples, air disturbance and air displacement; indicate increased bacterial counts and potential contamination of washed hands when Air Hand Dryers are used.
