Abstract: Lady beetles were collected in disturbed and undisturbed habitats to

investigate habitat preference and abundance of native and non-native lady beetles. Only 1.5% of lady beetles in these habitats were native species. Additionally, most non-native lady beetles were in undisturbed habitats, the assumed habitats of native lady beetles. This suggested that non-native lady beetles may be adversely affecting native lady beetles on Cape Breton

Island.
