

We are what we eat: Food shopping habits in the Hamilton population

Abstract: Poor food choices can lead to obesity and disease. We investigated the

food shopping choices in a population in Hamilton, Ontario, and studied the associations between location of the grocery store, characteristics of the shopper, and foods chosen. Hundred people were randomly interviewed. Our results revealed interesting trends and associations related to

demographic characteristics of the shopper.
