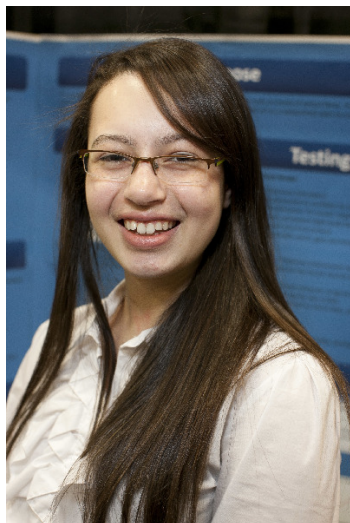

Making Connections: introducing the artificial nerve

Abstract: The purpose of this project was to design, build and test an artificial nerve composed primarily of optical fibres. This device acts as a replacement axon re-connecting damaged neurons. The device was tested successfully both ex vivo and in vivo (on a locust).
