S.O.S.: Stop Oil Spills- Results of an LC50 Study on Artemia Salina

Abstract: This project studied the effectiveness and safety of potential clean-up

While polymer and hair were effective and well tolerated by Artemia, soap was very toxic and most Artemia died when this agent was

used.
