Novel Concepts to Decontaminating Oiled Birds

Abstract: The efficacy of three water soluble cleaning agents and a new solventless decontaminant for the removal of Alberta crude oils from bird feathers was established. A novel quantitative test has been innovated to determine feather hydrophobic property. While Dawn? is the current choice detergent in removing oils, when properly developed, Elastol? has the potential of becoming the next standard of excellence in treating oiled birds.
