The Use of Nanocellulose in Producing a Flexible Organic Light Emitting Diode

Abstract: A blend of 37% wheat straw and 63% bacterial cellulose was

thermodynamically compatibilized to create a substrate for a flexible organic light emitting diode (OLED). Through electrolysis and the addition of an electroluminescence layer, an environmentally- sustainable and cost-efficient OLED was produced. The cellulosic substrate has various other medical and commercial applications, including electronic display systems

and wound dressing material.
