Abstract: The experiment tests students' short-term memories on certain days of the

week and times of the day. Additionally, the performances between genders on auditory and visual memory tests, chunking, and remembering difficult words are analyzed. Students between ages 15-18 participated in auditory and visual memory tests throughout the week. Overall, there were strong correlations between the factors that were looked into and the results.
