Abstract: The purpose of this experiment was to compare the heat retention of different types of insulation. Three materials were chosen as test insulation: newspaper, foam board, and spray foam. Each was compared to a control container. Results, after 30 minutes, showed newspaper worked best, followed by spray foam, then foam board. After 120 minutes, all three were essentially the same when looking at heat retention.
