Bacterial Presence and Contamination of Washed Hands After Using Air Hand Dryers

Abstract: The purpose of this project was to find an effective way to reduce the risk of

contaminating washed hands when air hand dryers are used. The hand dryers were swabbed before and after disinfecting and after applying an antimicrobial coating. Bacterial counts were obtained and the strains of bacteria were identified. Results confirmed the absence of human

pathogenic bacteria in the coated air hand dryer.
