Abstract: 150 participants, ages 8-13. Hypotheses tested: 1)at least 50% of students

are moderately addicted to video gaming 2)males are more likely addicted to gaming than females 3)most students' game on the weekend 4)if involved in ECA ,less likely to have an addiction. 81% participants-moderately/severely addicted. Both genders perceive themselves same level of addiction. Confirms if more time on ECA, less hours gaming.
