Pomegranate: The Fruit of Life for Cancer

Abstract: This project tests the anti-cancerous properties of a compound in the pomegranate fruit, called ellagic acid, against colon cancer cells. The growth of the cancer cells was tested after adding different dilutions of ellagic acid to them. Pomegranate showed a significant decrease in the number of cancer cells as compared to the control group. Hence, ellagic acid showed great potential as an anti-cancer agent.
