Abstract: A casual comment at the supper table led me to investigate the relation between baldness in men and memory-loss disorders. I developed a survey method, baldness rating scale and looked for a correlation between baldness and memory loss. My findings are significant enough to warrant further study - my investigation shows a possibility of correlation between having more hair and memory loss in men.
