Can Antioxidants prevent free radical damage, and possibly extend life?

Challenge: Health

Abstract: This experiment investigates benefits of antioxidants to health. Concentrations of blueberry, cranberry, and grape juices were mixed with yeast cells before ultraviolet light exposure to view the effects of antioxidants. Culture health was gauged on colony size. Results showed high amounts of juice resulted in least cell damage, supporting the hypothesis. Cranberry juice was found as most efficient in preventing cell damage, disproving the hypothesis.
