Pounding Cancer with PTEN

Abstract: Increased levels of the oncoprotein, beta-catenin, promotes tumor cell

metastasis. In melanoma, PTEN, a tumour suppressor and negative regulator of the PI3K pathway, is inactive or lost. We have determined that the re-introduction of PTEN to metastatic melanoma cells decreased active beta-catenin levels, and reduced the migratory and invasive potential of these cells. This investigation elucidated the putative mechanisms

underlying metastatic melanoma.
