

Project Unlike: A Novel Psychometric Screener to Quantify **Facebook Overuse**

**Abstract:** A novel psychometric screener (designed to quantify Facebook Overuse)

was drafted, statistically validated, and built as a web application. The screener was based upon two psychometric scales: one of novel creation measuring the intensity of an individual's psychogenic needs on Facebook, the other measuring their level of usage. This screener has applications in clinical psychology, behavioural-addictions, and could expand to assist the

diagnoses of social-disorders.
