Green Against Green: Bio-herbicides

Abstract: Garlic, ginger and lavender extracts were tested on mature dandelion plants

to observe their effectiveness as bio-herbicides. Four groups of plants were treated for two weeks, each with one of the extracts, plus one control group.

Lavender extract proved to be most effective, garlic treatment was inconclusive whereas ginger extract improved dandelion growth.
