Abstract: Women working in the sex trade in Kenya have been identified HIV-1

resistant. Through my experimentation, Human Leukocyte Antigen-G genotypes of HIV-1 infected and resistant individuals were determined using sequencing methods. \*010102/06 allele was associated with susceptibility and \*010101/0106 was associated with resistance, offering

new pathways for an HIV-1 vaccine.
