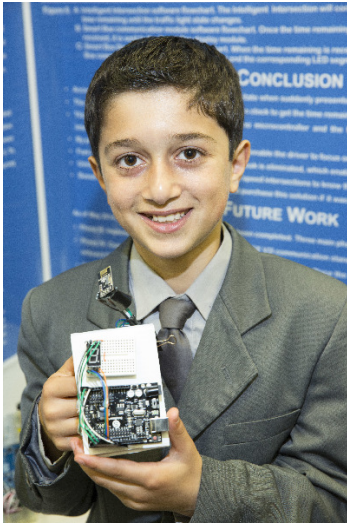

Abstract: Intelligent Intersection improves the driver safety while crossing a traffic light controlled intersection. The Intelligent Intersection system will continuously broadcast the time remaining before the traffic light changes to approaching vehicles.
