

Abstract: The purpose was to demonstrate the importance of MOAP-1 in regulating

> inflammation. Wild-type, Moap-1 and Rassf1a knockout mice were treated to 3% DSS solution for to induce inflammation followed by regular water. The mice were observed for signs/severity of inflammation. Moap-1 knockouts were injected with Pifithrin-u? and Gleevec to study the mechanisms of protein activity in inflammation/recovery. Patients may

benefit from drugs inhibiting apoptosis.
