Abstract: Exploring how the depth and density of leaves on a tree affect its cooling

properties. Several different experiments conducted related distance, temperature, and leaf density and leaf properties. The various plants species' densities and leaf properties were measured specifically and recorded. Mathematical equations were developed to relate each plant's ability to cool a temperature probe to the plant's overall characteristics,

giving comparisons to planted trees.
