Abstract: My project is an atmospheric analysis which aims at comparing, quantifying

and modeling specific mechanical and thermodynamic relationships between multiple meteorological parameters and indices that are associated with severe tornado outbreaks in the United States. This in-depth data analysis connects the effects of thermodynamic instability, wind shear, dew point depression and various other meteorological parameters and indices to better predict severe tornado outbreaks.
